John Wilson died in Fairfield County, South Carolina some time between December 1799 and August 1800, between the date when he made his will and when the will was filed in Fairfield County. He married Rebecca.

John and Rebecca's children were:

1. James Wilson.
2. Theophilus Wilson was born about 1760 in Fairfield County. He married Susan by 1840. She was at least his second marriage. She was born about 1795 in Fairfield County.

They are listed on the 1840 Census in Fairfield County (at page 190) and 1850 Census in Fairfield County (at page 259) with his occupation as a planter.

He owned 100 acres on Rice Creek and 50 acres of Sawyer's Tract on the North side of Bear Creek.

They were members of the O. S. Presbyterian Church in Fairfield County. They moved to Tipton County, Tennessee in the fall of 1849 and became members of the Associate Reformed Presbyterian Church at Salem in the spring of 1850.¹

They owned 460 acres on small branches of Jackson Creek of the waters of the Broad River, which they sold on February 3, 1846. 200 acres of the 460 was originally granted to a William Wilson in 1770.
